

Juneteenth Jubilee Art Auction Privacy Policy

Introduction

The Juneteenth Jubilee Association ("we," "our," "us") is committed to protecting the privacy and security of the personal information of artists ("you," "your") participating in the Juneteenth Jubilee Art Auction ("Auction"). This Privacy Policy outlines the types of personal information we collect, how we use it, and the measures we take to ensure it is protected. By participating in the Auction, you consent to the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

Information We Collect

We collect the following types of personal information from artists who participate in the Auction:

Contact Information: Name, address, phone number, and email address.

Artistic Information: Details about the art pieces being submitted, including titles, descriptions, dimensions, and images.

Financial Information: Bank account details or other payment information for processing payments and commissions.

Professional Information: Artist biography, resume, and other relevant professional details.

Participation Information: Records of your participation in the Auction, including sales and earnings data.

How We Use Your Information

Data Encryption: Encryption of sensitive financial information during transmission and storage.

Access Controls: Restricting access to personal information to authorized personnel only.

Security Protocols: Regularly reviewing and updating our security practices to ensure data integrity.

Sharing Your Information

We **do not** sell or rent your personal information to third parties. We may share your information with:

Service Providers: Third-party vendors who assist us in operating the Auction and providing services, subject to confidentiality agreements.

Legal Requirements: Government authorities or other entities when required by law or necessary to protect our legal rights.

Your Rights

You have the right to:

Access and Update: Access and update your personal information at any time by contacting us.

Withdraw Consent: Withdraw your consent to our processing of your personal information, which may affect your ability to participate in the Auction.

Delete: Request the deletion of your personal information, subject to our legal obligations.
